Winemakers Notes

We love rosé. It's pink, it's fun, and it's flirtatious. As the ultimate food pairing wine, you can put it alongside anything and it will excite your senses without being pretentious. Whole clusters of dark and deliciously ripened Pinot Noir were pressed gently, which means the wine is lighter in color, but not at all lacking in quality. Diverse and complex flavors of rose petal, strawberry, and hawthorn flower make it a little more serious, but if we're being perfectly honest, we taste the pineapple flavor of a white gummy bear on the finish. (Like we said, no pretension here.) Either way, we'd all loudly agree it's the best rosé we've ever made if we could only stop drinking it long enough.
